

Dear EDUCATE subscriber,

Welcome to the November 2011 Edition of **EDUCATE News!**

The **deadline for submission** of entries to the EDUCATE Prize – **9th December 2011, 5pm** (Central European Time) – is rapidly approaching.

To date, more than 100 registrations from academics external to the EDUCATE Consortium have been received from 24 different countries worldwide, with more than 350 new student users having been given free access to the EDUCATE Knowledge Base. Due to a number of requests, the **deadline for registration** has been extended to the **8th December 2011**.

To submit one entry per Category to the EDUCATE Prize, registered academics need go to the Prize Submission menu, which is shown on their EDUCATE Portal account and click on Submission. This will redirect to the submission area from where entries can be uploaded.

Details of the submission requirements are illustrated on pages 12 and 13 of the EDUCATE Prize Briefing Document downloadable from www.educate-sustainability.eu/prize

For **Category I** and **Category II**, the submission requirements are:

- **2 x A1 design posters** saved as PDF files, portrait format, featuring graphical information as appropriate and explanatory notes by the author(s) (max. 200 words)
- **1 x A4 page brief** and synthetic description of the pedagogical process (single sided)
- Short and incisive title

For **Category III**, the submission requirements are:

- **1 x digital presentation** (e.g. video, short essay, artwork, etc.)
- **1 x A4 page brief** and synthetic description of the pedagogical process (single sided)
- Short and incisive title

Design posters, digital presentations and 1-page briefs must not contain any information about the author(s), the academic staff member and their home institution. The maximum file size for submitted documents is 50Mbytes. Word limit for essays in Category III is 1,500 words.

All entries will need to be uploaded in the Submission area of the EDUCATE Portal under the responsibility of the registered academic member of staff. Submissions in any other format (e.g. via email, post, fax, etc.) or exceeding the requirements herein listed will not be considered eligible. Each entry will only be identified by a code that will be automatically assigned by the EDUCATE Portal at the moment of submission.
